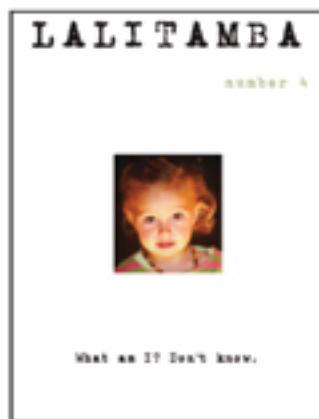
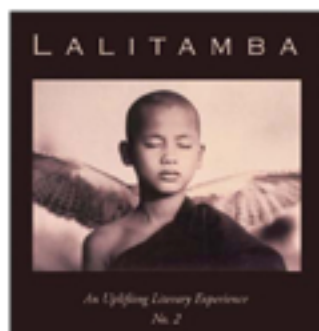

LALITAMBA
