Deadline is January 15, 2018.

All full-length poetry manuscripts are welcome. There is no preferred style, though full-length poetry manuscripts should be at least 48 pages.

Submission fee is \$22.50.

Submittable saves paper and helps keep things organized, so please don't send manuscripts by email or traditional post.

We read manuscripts blind, so exclude identifying information from the manuscript itself. All necessary contact information is included in your Submittable file.

Simultaneous submissions are accepted and encouraged, but please contact us immediately if your manuscript is accepted elsewhere.



Final judge this year is **ANDREW GRACE**, author of *A Belonging Field* (Salt Publishing, 2001), *Shadeland* (Ohio State University Press, 2008) and *Sancta* (Ahsahta Press, 2012). His poems have appeared in *Poetry*, *Boston Review*, *Iowa Review*, *TriQuarterly*, and *Prairie Schooner*, among other journals and magazines. He has been a Wallace Stegner Fellow in poetry at Stanford and winner of an Academy of American Poets Prize. Grace currently teaches at Kenyon College.
