Tartt First Fiction Award, rules 2020



- 1. Winning short story collection will be published by Livingston Press at the University of West Alabama, in simultaneous hardcover and trade paper editions, also in e-book and Kindle. Winner will receive \$1000, plus our standard royalty contract, which includes 50 copies of the book.
- 2. Author must not have had book of short fiction published at time of entry, though novels or poetry are okay. In keeping with Ruby Pickens Tartt's biography, we are looking for an author who has yet to publish a fiction collection.
- 3. Stories may have been published by magazines or in anthologies, though the author should have all rights. Magazines will be acknowledged. Include a list of publications, if so desired. We encourage manuscripts where at least half the stories have been published in magazines.
- 4. Manuscript length: 160-275 pages.
- 5. Deadline for email: This year ONLY, because of COVID-19 the email deadline will be March 15, 2021.
- 6 Entry fee: No entry fee.
- 7. Please email your entry to jwt@uwa.edu as either a Word document or a PDF. Please use the following format in your subject line and for the title of your file:

Tarttentry YourLastName YourFirstName

- 8. You should list your name, contact, and any publications within the manuscript.
- 9. Winner will be announced in summer 2021. Publication in spring 2022.
- 10. Winner must be an American citizen; work must be in English.
- 11. Style and content of manuscripts are completely open.
